2023 WHITECAPS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

MATT MANNING

Position: Pitcher Height: 6'6" Throws: Right

Birthday: January 28, 1998

Hometown: Sacramento, California

Entering his fourth season in Detroit, right-hand pitcher Matt Manning has established himself as a foundational piece of the Tigers' rebuilding efforts. The California native was drafted 9th overall by Detroit in 2016, and quickly rose through the minor league ranks with his electric fastball and promising secondary pitches.

Manning spent parts of the 2017 and 2018 season with the Whitecaps, starting 16 games and striking out 102 batters during his time in West Michigan. Manning announced his arrival on the national stage in 2018, when he earned a spot on the All-Start Futures Game roster. After dominating across three levels in 2019, he made his eagerly anticipated MLB debut in June 2021. The -25-year-old has delivered on his potential in the big leagues, using his mid-90s fastball and sharp curveball to strike out batters at an impressive rate. Though injuries have interrupted his momentum at times, Manning has still turned in strong performances like his 8-inning, 0-run game against Cleveland in 2022.

With his competitive fire, athletic 6'6" frame and track record of improvement, Manning is projected to take another step forward in 2024. As an anticipated roster holder within the starting rotation, he could be a central figure in the Tigers' push back into contention. Manning's best years may still be ahead, as Detroit fans watch the young ace lead the next era of Tigers baseball.

SPECIAL GUESTS



LANCE PARRISH

Former Tigers catcher Lance "Big Wheel" Parrish returns as special assistant to the Tigers GM, Jeff Greenberg this coming season. Drafted by the Tigers in 1974, his baseball career spanned 18 years, spending 12 with the Detroit organization. He was named an All-Star in 1980 and earned his World Series ring in 1984. His career batting average was .252 with 324 home runs and 1,070 RBIs. After his playing career, Parrish worked as a catching instructor, coach, manager, and broadcaster.



DAVE ROZEMA

Grand Rapids native and former Tiger Dave Rozema, drafted by the Tigers in 1975, spent nine years with the organization, including as a rostered pitcher on 1984 World Series championship team. In 1977 Rozema made his big-league debut and earned post-season honors as the American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and Tigers Rookie of the Year. In his career, he had a 60-53 win-loss record, 3.47 ERA and 448 strike outs.



DAN PETRY

Former Tigers pitcher Dan Petry returns for his fifth season as studio analyst for the Detroit Tigers on Bally Sports Detroit, after eight years serving as a color analyst on the Detroit Tigers Radio Network. Petry debuted for the Tigers in July 1979 and retired as a Red Sox in 1991. He spent nine years as a Tiger, winning a World Series championship and elected to the American League All-Star team. His career stats include 125-104 win-loss record, with 3.95 ERA and 1,063 strike outs.



JEFF GREENBERG

Jeff Greenberg was named the 20th General Manager in Tigers franchise history in September 2023. Greenberg joined the Tigers after spending time in Chicago with the Chicago Blackhawks and 11 seasons with the Chicago Cubs, including his final three seasons as an Assistant General Manager. He also held roles as Director of Pro Scouting and Baseball Operations. Before his time with the Cubs, Greenberg was an intern with the Pittsburgh Pirates, Arizona Diamondbacks and Major League Baseball.
